At the spring meeting it was voted to spend \$3,000 to have the road graded. We tried to get the grader operator to continue grading to the airport but he was unable to do so because he had a backlog of roads to do for forestry. At this late date we feel that we should wait until spring to get the road graded. The \$3,000 for the grading will not be spent on plowing, but will be put aside for the grading as was voted at the meeting.

If anyone has some time and energy there are trees leaning over the road in various spots that need to be removed. There have been some people working on the road, but more needs to be done.
